

What we ask you to do before Check-Out

We want to return all of your Recycling and Laundry deposit, so we have extended check out to 12:00 noon to give you extra time.

Recycling and rubbish

Please sort your rubbish and put it in the bins at the gate. The council will not take the recycling if it includes rubbish, and sorting other peoples' rubbish is a high infection risk.

We will deduct £50 from your deposit if we have to do this.

- Recycling (paper, card, clean tins, clean plastic, NOT GLASS)
- Rubbish (including dog poo bags) in black bin bags
- Glass Please take glass with you. The supermarkets all have bottle banks for clean glass, ie Lidl (on the A99 south), the Co-Op (on the road to Thurso) and Tesco (on the road to John o'Groats).
- **Kitchen waste** if applicable, put it in the compost heap by the walled garden or put it in with your general rubbish

Laundry

Bed linen is the highest contact surface in the Cottage. Please strip the bed-linen, mattress protectors and pillow protectors off the beds and put them into the clear laundry bags provided, along with your towels and tea towels. You will need at least one bag per bedroom.

We will deduct £50 from your deposit if we have to do this.
